'Crafted' prayer for development of LivingWell Centre vision

I thought it would be helpful this week to add a few notes to help explain some of the content of the 'crafted' prayer we handed out to those at the prayer meeting last Friday & at Church this Sunday [pick up your copy ASAP!].

Psalm 36 – Similar to the Lord's Prayer model, an opening address in our prayer to acknowledge the character of God as we begin with worship & praise.

Base Camp – this was a word shared about the Church being like a military base camp. Set up to provide resources, training & equipping for soldiers to be sent on forays into enemy territory. Also a place for refueling & camaraderie.

Oasis – refreshment – safety – encounter – reality - honesty – all key words related to some of the values for this place of meeting with God at the Well...

Alignment - Call of God to hear the drum beat and get into line with his purposes, standing shoulder to shoulder and for us to be **fine tuned** to God's word & will. Word shared about a cricket *snickometer* – a measuring instrument designed to detect the slightest of snicks, confirmed independently by word about tuning in a radio station to exact frequency.

Wind of God's Spirit – Picture shared of a ship with hoisted sails, only able to move when filled with wind [**faith**] and travel in the right direction.

Heart & skills – a further **base camp** reference, this time applied to the variety of skills needed by a team camped ready to climb a mountain. Pray for people to employ their unique skills / gifts to help the Church reach its highest goals. Character [**heart**] is crucially linked to gifting [**skills**].

Testimony – the woman at the Well's personal story [and willingness to share it] was crucial in reaching her community to reap a **harvest**. Jesus called for a change of perspective, open your eyes & see the possibilities! [John 4:35-38].
